### Into the WORD/APPLICATION:

- 1. Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-8
  - a. Why is Paul condemning their behavior? What does he mean by "why not rather suffer wrong" (verse 7)?

- 2. Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-20.
  - a. What's the difference between unrepentant, habitual sin and struggling with sin? Can a true Christian live in habitual, unrepentant sin?
  - b. How is the biblical view of sex good news to a culture that finds it restrictive and outdated?

- c. How is sexual sin unique from other sins? What is Paul's advice on how to flee sexual sin, and How can we apply this to our lives? (See also: 1st Thessalonians 4:1-8)
- d. Paul concludes this chapter by reminding the Corinthians of the gospel (verse 20). How does the gospel motivate us toward obedience?

e. Are there any sins in your life that you need to confess and seek accountability for?
